A Letter to Jubilee*

Dear Jubilee Ministries,

Hello there. I am currently an inmate in a state facility. Back in 2017, I was incarcerated in a different prison where you had chaplains. I wanted to express my sincerest gratitude for the kindness shown by Jubilee Ministries to inmates at that prison. My time incarcerated there was quite traumatic. I was housed in the protective custody block at the time. It was very difficult for inmates there - most are forgotten by almost all, except by your organization.

In my heart of hearts, I nearly gave up hope during that period of incarceration. But, the charitable actions of Jubilee Ministries saved me from giving up on this life. God, and His Son, Jesus Christ, were not a part of my life prior to my incarceration. However, thanks to the sincere compassion of your chaplains, I've adopted Christianity. Life feels far less desolate now that I know God is always by my side. Thank you so very much for instilling hope in my heart when there was despair.

I guess we didn't break enough stuff for Clair to fix, so in 2018 he began repairing donated bikes for sale in our thrift stores – AS A VOLUNTEER! From 2018-2021, Clair's SUV would often be seen coming and going from the Jubilee parking lot with multiple bikes attached. Check out the following statistics. From 2018-2021 Clair...

- Prepared 1,291 bikes for sale in our stores at a value of \$61,999.
- Spent only \$1,601 on parts.
- Donated personal resources and countless hours to put many adults and children on a safe, value-priced bicycle.

Clair recently stepped away from his staff and volunteer roles with Jubilee after nearly 50 years! He began volunteering with the ministry in 1973.
