Women's Aftercare Update



Since its doors opened one year ago, the Women's Aftercare Program has ministered to 8 students. While in the program, students attend personal devotions and Bible studies in the morning, engage in discipleship curriculum in the afternoon, and participate in community-building activities most evenings, all while receiving on-the-job training in Jubilee's thrift operation. On the weekends, the students enjoy game night with volunteers and staff, worship nights, church, and various scheduled activities. As part of their discipleship, students learn to develop a budget and become financially responsible. Their daily schedules and goals are structured intentionally to promote spiritual growth and personal responsibility.

We have been blessed to witness God changing lives! One of the students stated that "she wants

to fall in love with Jesus like she loved public icons in her old life." Another woman rededicated her life to Jesus and was baptized. Two students were seen and heard singing a worship song with their hands held high in the waters of a state park as part of a group outing. One woman cries out for true life change on the inside—stating she does not want to be the way she was before. This happens every time old behavior pops up, and she feels defeated by it.

Small shifts in self-awareness, desires, and thoughts are signs of the real growth that we witness. These experiences keep the Women's Aftercare Team encouraged and hopeful that these students, and many more to come, will surrender their past and walk forward with Jesus. Pray for their lives to be changed through the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In Memory of Clair Weaver

1949-2023

The stories of Jubilee Ministries and Clair Weaver have been intertwined for 50 years. As Jubilee was getting off the ground in the 1970s, Clair was a young volunteer who went into the jail to minister to inmates behind bars. We continue to share stories today of lives saved and changed from those early ministry days in the Lebanon County Correctional Facility.

Years later, in 1991, Clair became the Executive Director of Jubilee. He brought strong leadership and a big vision to the ministry, leading the effort to purchase and renovate the building on 12th Street in the City of Lebanon. This was a building many thought was far too big and too broken to be useful. Clair possessed a fearless optimism that not only brought hopeless buildings to life, but also brought the hope of the Gospel to men and women affected by incarceration.

During his service, Jubilee expanded its chaplain presence in county and state prisons in Pennsylvania, opened several new thrift stores, and launched an Aftercare Program for those being released from prison.

I was blessed to not only know Clair, but to work for Clair. He was my mentor – guiding me in my leadership, sharing his wisdom, and teaching me in ways that came to fruition years down the road. With grace, he welcomed me into his leadership role at Jubilee, a position he served in for 25 years. After this transition, he was always willing to provide advice and historical perspective to the challenges I was facing.

As a testament to Clair's impactful service at Jubilee, several men who had been a part of our programs spoke at his memorial service about the influence that Clair had on their lives through the Gospel of Jesus Christ! We remember Clair when we read this verse from Matthew 25:21. "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'"
